information :—

**ACT\_No. [X oF 1985**

An Act further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1976

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Representation of the People  
Act, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

Tt is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short fife and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the  
Representation of the People (Seventh Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 64, Act LXXXV of 1976.—In the Representation  
of the People Aci, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), in section 64, after the word  
“sections \*,” the figure and comma “476,” shall be inserted.

3. Repeal.—The Representation of the People (Seventh Amendment) Ordinance, 1985 (XXIV of 1985), is hereby repealed.

3. Amendment of section \$9, Acti LAAAY of iY76.—In the wi Act in section 99, in sub-section (i), afier clause (c), the ivilowing uest clause shall be inserded, namely :—

“(ee) he, being a person elected to the National Assembly or a Provincial Assembly, is found by the Commission to have subscribed, after the commencement of the Representation of the People (Eight Amendment) Ordinance, toss, citer as proposer or seconder, in Contvention of the provisions of this Act or the rules made thereunder, to the nomination of more than one candidate for a seat or seats ; or”,

4, Repeal.—The Representation of the People (Eighth Amendment) Ordinance, 1985 (XXVI of 1985), is hereby repealed,

An Act further to amend the Members of Parliament (Salaries and Allowances) Act,

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Members of Parliament (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1974 (XXVII of 1974), for the purposes herein-after appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement— (i) this Act may be called the Members of Parliament (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the first day of March, 1985.

2, Amendment of section 3, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the Members of Parliament (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1974 (KAVI of 1974), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 3, for the words “one thousand and five hundred” the words “three thousand” shall be substituted,

3. Amendment of section 4, Act KAVI of 1974,—in the said Act, in section 4, in sub-section (1), for the words “fifty rupees” the words “one hundred and fifty rupees”, and for the words twenty-five rupees” the words “one hundred rupees”, shall be substituted.

4. Amendment of section 5, Act YMVIL of 1974.—In the said Act, in section 5, in sub-section (1),—

(a) in clause (a), for the word “third” the word “second” shall be substituted ;

(b) in clause (b), for the words “one and one-half of the first class air fare” the words “the aggregate of one economy class air fare and one second class railway fare” shall be substituted ; and

{c) in clause (c), for the words "one rupee per mile" the words " two rupees per kilometre" shall be substituted,

5. Substitution of section 9, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the said Act, for section 9 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“9. Housing allowance—A member shall be paid a housing allowance at the rate of three hundred rupees for each day during any period of residence on duty. ”,

6. Amendment of section 16, Acf XXVIT of 1974.—In the said Acl, in section 10—

(a) in sub-section (1), for the words “six thousand and six hundred rupees ”, twice occurring, the words “fifteen thousand rupees” shall be substituted ; and

(b) in sub-section (2), for the words “four thousand and two hundred rupees bears to the sum of six thousand and six hundred rupees” the words “ten thousand rupees bears to the sum of fifteen thousand rupees ” shail be substituted.

7. Substitution of section 11, Act XXVIE of 1974—In the said Act, for section il the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“IL. Telephone—A member shall be entitled to have a telephone installed at his residence at Government expenses where facilities for installation are available and to a monthly allowance of five hundred rupees on account of telephone charges, whether a telephone is so installed or not. ”.

8. Insertion of new section ILA, Act XX VII of 1974,—In the said Act, after section 11, amended as aforesaid, the following new section shall be inserted, namely :—

“LILA. Office maintenance allowance—A member shall be entitled to

receive an office maintenance allowance at the rate of seven hundred and fifty rupees per mensem, ”.

9. Additional of new section 144A, Act XXVIII of 1974.—In the said Act, alier section 14, the following new section shall be added, namely :—

“4A. Act to have effect subject to instructions, etc—This Act — shall have effect subject to such instructions, rules, exceptions, further concessions or casemernts as the Federal Goyernment may from time to time issue or grant.”.
