Islamabad, the 26th April, 1976

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 18th April, 1976, and is hereby published for general information :—

An Act to provide for the conduct of elections to the reserved seats in the National, Assembly and the Provincial Assemblies.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the conduct of elections to the reserved seats in the National Assembly and the Provincial Assemblies and to guard against corrupt and illegal practices and other offences at or in connection with such elections and for the determination of doubts and disputes arising out of or in connection with elections, and other matters arising out of or connected therewith ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

CHAPTER I—PRELIMINARY

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the National and Provincial Assemblies (Elections to Reserved Seats) Act, 1975.

(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Definitions.—In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

(i) "Article" means Article of the Constitution ;

{ii} "Assembly" means the National Assembly or a Provincial Assembly for a Province ;

___ 57. Repeal.—Chapter V of the National and Provincial Assemblies (Elections) Ordinance, 1970 (XIII of 1970), and the National and Provincial Assemblies (Elections to Reserved Seats)rdinance, 1976 (VI of 1976), are hereby repealed.

The following Acts of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 19th April, 1976, and are hereby published for general information :—

ACT No. XIX OF 1976

An Act to declare the holders of the office of Adviser to the Governor not to be disqualified from being elected or chosen as, and from being, a member of Parliament or a Provincial Assembly ;

WHEREAS paragraph (d) of clause (1) of Article 63 read with Article 127 of the Constitution provides that a person holding any office of profit in the service of Pakistan may be declargl by law not to be disqualified from being elected or chosen as, and from being, a member of Parliament or a Provincial Assembly ;

AND, WHEREAS, it is expedient in the public interest to declare that persons holding the office of Adviser to a Governor during certain period shall not be disqualified from being elected 0; chosen as. and from being, a member of Parliament or a Provincial Assembly ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1, Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Members of Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Exemption of Advisers from Disqualification) Act, 1976.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the thirty-first day of December, 1975.

2. Adviser to Governor not to be disqualified.—It is hereby declared that any person holding the office of Adviser to the Governor of a Province during the period —

(a) that an Order under paragraph (c) of clause (2) of Article 232 of the Constitution is in force whereby the Federal Government has assumed to itself, or directed the Governor of a Province to assume on its behalf, all or any of the functions of the Government of that Pro-

vince ; Or .

(b) a Proclamation under Article 234 of the Constitution is in force ;

shall not be disqualified from being elected or chosen as, and from being, a member of Parliament or a Provincial Assembly.

3. Repeal.The Members of Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Exemption of Advisers from Disqualification) Ordinance, 1976 (I of 1976), is hereby

repealed.
