Act No, VII of 1991

An Act to amend the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies ( Disqualification for Membership) Order, 1977

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership) Order, 1977 [P. (P.P.) O. No. of 17 of 1977], for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows —

1. Short title and commencement—(1) This Act may be called the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership) (Amendment) Act, 1991,

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Insertion of new Article 6A, P. (P.P.) O. No. 17 of 1977.—in the Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership) Order, 1977 [P. (P.P.) O. No, 17 of 1977], hereinafter referred to as the said Order, after Article 6, the following new Article shall be inserted, namely —

“OA Transfer of cases, etc—(1) Where two or more Special Courts have been established and the Supreme Court is satisfied that, for the general convenience of the parties or witnesses or for the ends of justice, it is expedient to do so, the Supreme Court may direct that a case specified by it shall stand transferred from one Special Court to another.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Parliament and  
Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership) Ordér, 1977  
[P. (P.P.) O. No. 17 of 1977], for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short.title and commencement.—(!) This Act may be called the  
Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership)  
(Second Amendment) Act, 1991.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Article 3, P. (P.P.) O. No. 17 of 1977.—In the  
Parliament and Provincial Assemblies (Disqualification for Membership)  
Order, 1977 [P. (P.P.) O. No. 17 of 1977], in Article 3, in clause (3),—

(a) after the word “place”, the words “or places” shall be inserted ;  
and

(b) for the full-stop at the end a colon shall be substituted and there  
after the following proviso shall be added, namely :—

“Provided that a Special Court may, either of its own motion  
or at the request of any party, sit at such other place as it may  
decide in the interest of justice, having regard to the general  
convenience of the parties and the production of evidence.”,
