ACT No. X oF 1974

An Act to provide for the appointment of Legal Advisers to companies

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the appointment of Legal Advisers  
to companies and matters connected therewith ;

} It is hereby enacted as follows :—

. 1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the  
Companies (Appointment of Legal Advisers) Act, 1974.

(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Definitions.—In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the sub-  
ject or context,—

(a) “advocate” means an advocate entered in any roll under the pro-  
visions of the Legal Practitioners and Bar Councils Act, 1973  
(XXXV of 1973);

-(b) “company” means a company formed and registered under the  
Companies Act, 1913 (VII of 1913), but does not include \_a\_com-

ao company limited by guarantee or an associatign registered under

ACT No. XIE OF 1974

An Act further to amend the Succession Act, 1925

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Succession Act, 1925 (XXXIX of 1925), for the purposes hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title, extent and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Succession (Amendment) Act, 1974.

(2) It extends to the whole of Pakistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendmeni of section 211, Act XXXIX of 1925.—In the Succession Act, 1925 (XXXIX ci 1925), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 211, in sub-section (2), for the words ‘or Jaina” the comma and words “ , Jaina or Parsi’ shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of section 212, Act XXXIX of 1925.—In the said Act, in section 212, in sub-section (2), after the word “Jaina”, the comma and word “Parsi” shall be inserted.

4. Amendment of section 213, Act XXXIX of 1925.—In the said Act, in section 213, for sub-section (2) the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“(2) This section shall not apply in the case of wills made by Muhammadans, and shall only apply—

(a) in the case of wills made by any Hindu, Budhist, Sikh or Jaina, where such wills are of the classes specified in clauses (a) and (b) of section \$7; and

(b) im the case of wills made by any Parsi dying after the commence-ment of the Succession (Amendment) Act, 1974, where such wills are made within the local limits of the ordinary civil jurisdiction of the Sind and Baluchistan High Court, and where such wills are made outside those limits, in so far as they relate to immo-vab’e property situaie within those limits. ”.

ACT No. XIII of 1974

An Act further to amend the Income-tax Act, 1922

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;
