The following Act of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 24th January, 1993 and is hereby published for general information :—

Act No. I of 1993

An Act further to amend the Suppression of Terrorist Activities (Special Courts ) Act, 1975

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Suppression of Terrorist Activities (Special Courts) Act, 1975 (XV of 1975), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Suppression of Terrorist Activities (Special Courts) (Amendment) Act, 1993,

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 5A, Act XV of 1975.—In the Suppression of Terrorist Activities (Special Courts) Act, 1975 (XV of 1975), in section 5A,—

for sub-section (8), the following shall be substituted, namely :—

(8) An accused person shall not be released on bail by a Special Court or by any other court, if there appear reasonable grounds for believing that he has been guilty of a scheduled offence; nor shall an accused person be so released unless the prosecution has been given notice to show cause why he should not be so released".

3. Repeal.—The Suppression of Terrorist Activities (Special Courts) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992 (XXII of 1992), is hereby repealed.
