Ordinance

to repeal the Medical Colleges (Governing Bodies) Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of the Punjab.

Preamble.- WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Medical Colleges (Governing Bodies) Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of the Punjab;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of the Punjab is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance, namely:—

1. Short title, extent and commencement.— (1) This Ordinance may be called the Medical Colleges (Governing Bodies) (Punjab Repeal) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Punjab.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Repeal of Ordinance XIII of 1961.- The Medical Colleges (Governing

Bodies) Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of the Punjab, is hereby repealed.

'This Ordinance was promulgated by the Governor of the Punjab on 20th November, 1970; published in the Punjab Gazette (Extraordinary), dated 21st November, 1970, pages 513-514; saved by Article 281 of the Interim Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan (1972); and, validated by the Validation of Laws Act, 1975 (LXIII of 1975).
