

SINDH ACT NO. XIX OF 1972.
THE FOREST (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1972.

[28th December, 1972]

An Act to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter

appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Forest(Sind Amendment) Act, 1972.
- (2) It shall be come into force at once.
2. In the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of

Sind, hereinafter referred to as the said act, in section 67, for the

words "Magistrate of the first class", the words "Special Executive Magistrate" shall be substituted.

3. In the said Act, in section 68 for sub-section (3) the

following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:-

"(3) A Forest officer shall not be empowered under this section unless he is a Forest-officer of a rank not inferior to that of a Ranger, and the sum of money accepted as compensation under clause (a) of sub-section (1) shall in no case exceed the sum of five hundred rupees".

4. In the said Act, for the cattles and amount of fines mentioned in section 71, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"For each Elephant Fifty rupees.

For each Camel Forty rupees.

For each Buffalo Twenty five rupees.

For each horse, mare, gelding
Pony, colt, filly, mule, bull,
Bullock, cow, or heifer

Fifteen rupees.

For each calf, ass, ram, ewe,
Sheep, lamb, goat or kid.

Ten rupees."
