

SINDH ACT NO. V OF 1990

THE SINDH ASSEMBLY MEMBERS  
(SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1990.

[16th July, 1990]

An Act to amend the Sind Assembly Members (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1974.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Assembly Preamble. Members (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1974, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Assembly Members Short title = and (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1990. commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Assembly Members (Salaries and Allowances) Amendment \_\_\_\_\_ of Act, 1974, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 3, for Section 3 of Sind Act, the words “two thousand” the words “two thousand and five XXVI of 1974. hundred” shall be substituted.

3. In the said Act, in section 4, for the words “one hundred Amendment \_\_\_\_\_ of and fifty” the words “three hundred” shall be substituted. section 4 of Sind Act XXVI of 1974.

4. In the said Act, after section 5, the following new section \_ Insertion of section shall be inserted:— 5-A in Sind Act XXVI of 1974.

Free Travelling, “5-A (1) A member shall be provided during a year with such vouchers of the value of twenty five thousand rupees as would enable him to travel within Pakistan at any time without payment of any fare by Air or by Rail:

Provided that, where a person becomes a Member during the course of a year, the value of vouchers with which he is provided during that year shall be reduced proportionately.

(2) A member who does not wish to be provided with the vouchers shall be paid an allowance of twenty thousand rupees in lieu of such vouchers.

(3) Any voucher with which a Member is provided

under sub-section (1) may be utilized by the family of the Member.

(4) The utilization by a Member of any voucher with

which he is provided under sub-section (1) for the purpose of any journey for which he is entitled to any travelling allowance under this Act shall not in any way effect his right to receive such allowance.

Explanation: For the purpose of this section, "family" means the spouse and children and "Member" includes the Speaker, the Deputy Speaker, a Minister, an Advisor to the Chief Minister, a Special Assistant to the Chief Minister, a Parliamentary Secretary and Leader of Opposition."

4-A. In the said Act, in section, 6; in clause (b), for the words "five hundred rupees", the words "two thousand rupees" shall be substituted;

4-B. In the said Act, after section 6-A, the following new section shall be inserted:—

Office maintenance allowance. "6-B. A Member shall be entitled to receive office maintenance allowance at the rate of one thousand and five hundred rupees

per month."

5. In the said Act, in section 7, in clause (a) for the words "two thousand" the words "three thousand" shall be substituted.
