THE SINDH EMERGENCY PROCUREMENT ACT, 2014

[26 February, 2014]

An Act to make provision for emergency procurement for the law enforcement agency in the Province of Sindh.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for emergency procurement for the law enforcement agency in the Province of Sindh, in the wake of targeted attacks and threats to the law enforcement agency and people of Province which has resulted into the loss of precious human lives and the properties including personnel of law enforcement agency;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Emergency Procurement Act, 2014.

(2) It shall extend to the whole of the Province of Sindh;

(3) It shall come into force at once and shall remain in force for one year from the date of its commencement.

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context —

(a) “emergency procurement” means the procurement made on urgent basis for the security and protection of the personnel of law enforcement agency and people of the Province;

(6) “law enforcement agency” means the Sindh Police, Sindh Prisons Police, Pakistan Rangers and Frontier Constabulary deployed in the Province of Sindh.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority Act, 2009 or rules made thereunder or any other law for the time being in force and the procedure of procurement laid down hereunder, the emergency procurement shall be made by the law enforcement agency on urgent basis.

4. The emergency procurement shall be made for the items, which relate to the security and protection of the personnel of law enforcement agency and people of the Province, such as armored personnel carrier bomb proof, bullet proof jackets, bullet proof helmets and bullet proof vehicles, arms and ammunitions of all types and any other related equipment.
