THE SINDH PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1996.

[13TM March, 1996]

An Act to amend the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act 1974

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances And Privileges) Act, 1974, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1996.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Parliamentary Secretaries (Salaries,

Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1974, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for section 3, the following shall be substituted:—

“3. Salary
and privilege.

(i)

A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to-

a salary of ten thousand one hundred and ninety rupees per month; and

(ii) an orderly allowance of one thousand rupees per month upto and inclusive of 31st August, 1995 and one thousand and six hundred rupees per month effect from 1st September, 1995.

(ii)

the use of an official car of 1300 cc (indigenously

manufactured) with a Driver maintained at Government expense.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 4-A, in sub-section (2), for the

words “one thousand five hundred per month”, the words “forty-five percent of the minimum of BS-21 as admissible in 1991”, shall be substituted.

4. In section 4-B, for clause (ii), the following shall be

substituted:—

“(ii) telephone facilities at residence and office at Government expense at the same scale as is admissible to an officer of BS-21.”
