

SIND ACT NO. II OF 1864.!

[THE 2SIND STEAM-VESSELS ACT, 1864.]

[2274 September, 1864.]

An Act to provide for the periodical survey of steam-vessels in the ports, harbours, rivers or waters of 3[\* \* Sind].

15. It is hereby declared that sections 292, 293, and 294

of the Merchant Shipping Act (17 and 18 Vict., cap. 104)<sup>4</sup>, and Schedule S\$ of that Act are and shall be applicable to all steam-vessels proceeding to sea from any port or place in 5[\* \* Sind] and that, in calculating the penalties mentioned in the said section 293, ten rupees be taken as the equivalent for one pound sterling.
